



Dear UC Davis community,

On February 9, 2019, the UC Student Association (UCSA) Board of Directors voted to no longer consider the Associated Students of the University of California Davis (ASUCD) a member in good standing of UCSA until ASUCD's outstanding debt of \$15,970.78 is received by UCSA in full. This decision was made according to the UCSA charter in consideration of the fact that ASUCD has been delinquent on conference fees, membership dues, and travel reimbursements for a period nearing one full calendar year.

This decision will suspend ASUCD representatives' voting rights on the UCSA Board. In addition, UCSA voted to suspend ASUCD's attendance privileges at UCSA's four annual conferences, including the upcoming 2019 UC Student Lobby Conference, unless payment of past due invoices are received before the first registration deadline of future conferences. ASUCD's privileges will be established again in full upon receipt of payment for the four following invoices:

- Registration fees at UC Student Lobby Conference 2018: \$4,440
- Registration fees at UC Student Organizing Summit 2018: \$3,960
- Lodging at UC Student Organizing Summit 2018: \$3,612.18
- 2018 academic year dues commitment (reduced by 90%): \$3,908.60

UCSA affirms the importance of having UC Davis at the table of systemwide student leadership. Since 2014, UCSA has continually extended financial support by waiving proportions of dues and fronting lodging at conferences to be handled by reimbursement later. This academic year, UCSA again agreed to waive 90% of ASUCD's membership dues. As an organization whose budget is almost entirely reliant on dues from campuses, this has been a significant financial investment made by UCSA in a good faith effort to represent UC Davis students. However, in the last year, UC Davis has failed to pay or respond to requests about payment for the small portion of their total share that ASUCD representatives previously promised to pay.

We regret to have to take interventive measures at this time, but can no longer responsibly cover ASUCD's financial commitments. Please consider this a formal request to deliver on these promised payments before additional actions are necessary to resolve this debt.
