








## Starbucks (ARC)








## Shields Library










## 24 Hour Study Room














## SciLab Study Lounge












#### Ciocolat











#### **Cloud Forest Cafe**










#### Peet's Coffee Downtown

#### Starbucks Downtown














#### Black Bear Diner






## Crepeville










## Starbucks University Mall






#### Starbucks West Davis


