

<p>ous diseases must necessarily be left largely to the management of physicians, hence I am of the opinion that it is a question in the sound discretion of the state and local boards of health in auditing the various accounts presented to them to decide at what period of time it was necessary to begin payment out of the fund to relieve the various counties of contagious diseases prevalent at the time the bill was passed.</p> <p>The latter part of section 1, in my judgment means that so much of the appropriation as may remain after being used for the purposes set forth in the first part of the section, shall be used to meet the current expenses of the board for the ensuing two years; that two years begins from the date of the passage of the bill. "Because the auditor is the general accountant, it does not follow as we have seen, that special authority may not be delegated to other officers or agents to audit accounts against the state. These exceptions to his general duties cover a large part of the public expenditures. Unless the power of revision is given by law, he does not derive it from the circumstance that a warrant must be issued by him, when the decision of the proper officer is certified to him, his act in issuing the warrant is as purely ministerial as the act of the treasurer who pays it." <i>Danley vs. Whiteley</i>, 14 Ark., 688, supra.</p>	<p>ing Attorney S.
