This day comes the State of Arkansas by **Sam M. Bains, H.L. Ponder and W.P. Smith**

Prosecuting Attorney, and comes the defendant in proper person in custody of the Sheriff and by his Attorney **W.A. Jackson and O.C. Blackford** and all parties hereto announcing ready for trial.

*Come T.M. Robertson and eleven other duly qualified Petit Jurors selected to try this cause, and after hearing all the evidence adduced, the argument of counsel and the instructions of the Court retired to the jury to consider of a verdict. After some deliberation the jury returned into open Court the following Verdict: We, the jury find the defendant Harvey Rose guilty of Voluntary Man Slaughter as charged in the indictment and fix his punishment at two years in the State Penitentiary."*

It is therefore considered, ordered and adjudged by the Court that said defendant be remanded into the custody of the Sheriff of **Lawrence** County, and to be by him safely and speedily transported to the Penitentiary House or State Convict Farm or Camps of the State of Arkansas, and there confined at hard labor for the period of **Two (2) year**

and that the State of Arkansas do have and recover of said defendant all the costs of this prosecution and have execution therefor. It is further ordered by the Court, that the Clerk of this Court make out and deliver to said Sheriff a certified copy of the foregoing judgment to be by him delivered to the Agent or Keeper of said Penitentiary as sufficient authority for him to receive and confine the said **Harvey Rose** in the manner aforesaid.
